Dear Martyn,

Apologise for late reply.

If you would like to bring shotguns or rifles temporarily into Spain you will have to apply for an authorization to the Direction General de la Guardia Civil. You can submit your application at the Consulate to be forwarded to them.

Your application must be submitted in Spanish, you should specify the number of arms, the places where you intend to use them and for how long. The maximum number allowed is three per person. The licence has a validity of three months.

The documents required to support your applications are your passport and any licenses or authorizations that allow you to have and use your arms in the UK. All the British documents must be legalised with the Hague Apostille and translated officially into Spanish by a translator recognised by the Ministerio de Exteriores.
